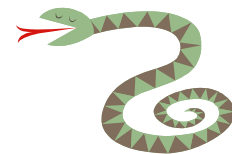
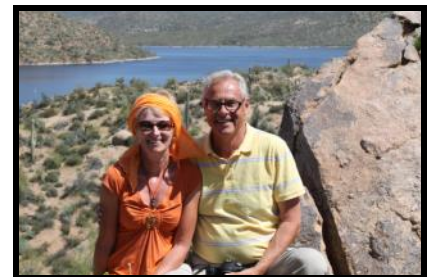
## Bartlett Lake—Rattlesnake Cove Picnic & Cruise
